





SUSTAINABILITY

(people gathered in teams didn't know each other prior to this initiative)

DIFFERENT LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE

among parents and teachers about eduactional policy

OTHER PEOPLE'S SHOES

Parents and teachers not being able to put themselves in another person's shoes

PARENTS AS IMPORTANT FACTOR

Not acknowledging parents as valuable resources, active participants



Lessons learned



THE RIGHT TIMING

for such an initiative in the society

MUTUAL RESPECT

LISTENING

Learning to listen to each other and understand different perspectives

THIS IS A PROCESS

and it takes time and persistence

MOTIVATION

is the key, parents and teachers need guidance and directions all the way

CAPACITY BUILDING

of both parents and teachers

SUPPORT

Constant mentoring and counselling and encouraging

TOGETHER

Creating frequent opportunities for meeting up, socializing and planning together

Lessons learned



ENGAGEMENT

Parents need to be engaged actively as creators and not mere observers

CHILDREN

should be involved in every joint activities

FINANCES

are not necessary for first joint activities

PLANNING OF ACTIVITIES

Activities should not be too ambitious in the beginning: gatherings, joint events, fairs, humanitarian events, etc.






Achievements
